Unlocking language and new career paths: Edna's Journey

Why did you enrol for the courses?

I moved to London seven years ago seeking new opportunities and to improve my English. After completing my degree, I needed Level 1 and Level 2 English and Maths qualifications to progress further. While searching for local courses, I discovered Wandsworth Lifelong Learning. It felt like the right choice – accessible, supportive, and structured.

Enrolling wasn't just about meeting requirements; it was about gaining practical skills for daily life, work, and future study.

Despite my degree, I lacked confidence in speaking and writing naturally. From day one, the course was welcoming. Tutors were patient, and fellow learners were supportive. Lessons focused on real-life situations, not just grammar. I learned to organise my writing, speak more confidently, and engage in conversations effectively.

What impact have the courses had on you?

This course has truly changed my life. Beyond improving my English, it opened doors I never imagined. Wandsworth Lifelong Learning supports wider goals, offering career advice and volunteering opportunities. When I mentioned wanting experience, my tutor connected me with

Age UK Wandsworth. Soon after, I began volunteering, which boosted my confidence and allowed me to contribute meaningfully. A few months later, I was offered a paid role as Community Engagement Project Assistant. That one conversation led to a new career path. For me, this course was about more than English – it gave me confidence, skills, and support to move forward.

Advice to others

Go for it – don't wait for the perfect time. At first, it is normal to feel unsure, especially if you have not studied in a while, or if you feel like your English is not good enough yet. Being nervous is normal, but these courses provide a safe, supportive environment to build skills. Wandsworth Lifelong Learning does not just help you with the subject; they take the time to understand your goals, whether it is for work, further study, or everyday life.

If you want to improve your English or start something new, this could be the opportunity that changes everything. It did for me.

Expanding knowledge for a public service role: Csaba's Journey

Why did you enrol for the courses?

I enrolled in a wide range of Wandsworth Lifelong Learning courses to support my personal growth, community engagement, and transition into public service. Each course was chosen to build practical skills aligned with my goal of contributing to local government and civic improvement.

Mental Health Level 1 and 2 gave me a strong foundation in emotional wellbeing and supporting individuals facing challenges – essential for public-facing roles. Courses like *How to Be an Effective Mentor and Positively Presenting Yourself* boosted my confidence and communication skills, while *Conflict Resolution* and *Conflict Management Level 2* taught me how to de-escalate tensions and foster respectful dialogue.

Team Leading Level 2 strengthened my ability to motivate and manage teams, and *Business Administration Level 1* improved my organisational and customer service skills. *Food Safety Level 1 and 2* ensured I understand health standards, while *Environmental Sustainability Level 1 and 2* deepened my commitment to eco-conscious practices. Finally, *Volunteering Level 1* reinforced the importance of civic engagement and collaborative service.

What impact have the courses had on you?

These courses gave me clarity, confidence, and readiness to pursue public service

roles – transforming my personal and professional outlook. They enhanced my leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills, while reinforcing values of empathy, integrity, and responsibility. Mental health training improved my ability to support others, and conflict management skills have already proven useful in team settings. Food safety and sustainability modules strengthened my awareness of health and environmental standards, and volunteering reaffirmed my passion for community engagement.

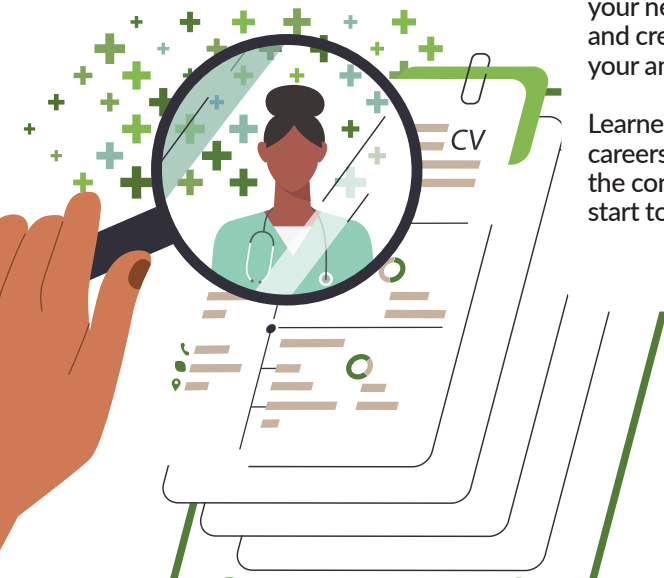

Personal and professional growth: Evelyn's Journey

Why did you enrol for the course?

Evelyn decided to enrol on the Business Administration Level 3 course with a clear goal in mind. Coming from a creative background, she wanted to upskill herself and better understand her job role and what was required of her. Her manager suggested that this course would not only improve her administrative skills but also teach her the fundamentals needed to excel in her role. Evelyn said, "I wanted to move up within the admin role, and to do this, I needed this qualification."

What impact has the course had on you?

The course had a profound impact on Evelyn, both professionally and personally. At work, she became more aware of her job role and what was expected of her. Evelyn noted, "The course has helped me develop my interpersonal skills, and I feel more confident interacting with residents and the wider team at work." She was able to implement the skills she learned in her daily work routine, gaining a better understanding of her job role and the importance of safeguarding.

In her personal life, Evelyn felt more organized and established a routine. She created a personal development plan for goals she wanted to achieve outside of work. Reflecting on her journey, Evelyn said, "Overall, I feel more confident, and I have a positive outlook on life."

In addition, Evelyn's commitment to upskilling herself to prepare for her role resulted in her nomination for our Learner of the Year Award in 2024.

Advice to others

Evelyn encourages others to take the leap and enrol on the course, even if it feels daunting at first. She acknowledges that studying after a long break can be intimidating but assures that the support from tutors makes the journey easier and more comfortable. "The entire team at Wandsworth Lifelong Learning are very supportive, so I will say take the chance, and you will be able to complete the course."

Evelyn's story demonstrates the power of education and how it can help you to change direction and aim for a new career.

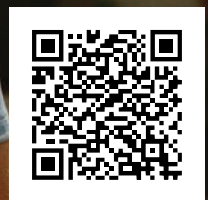

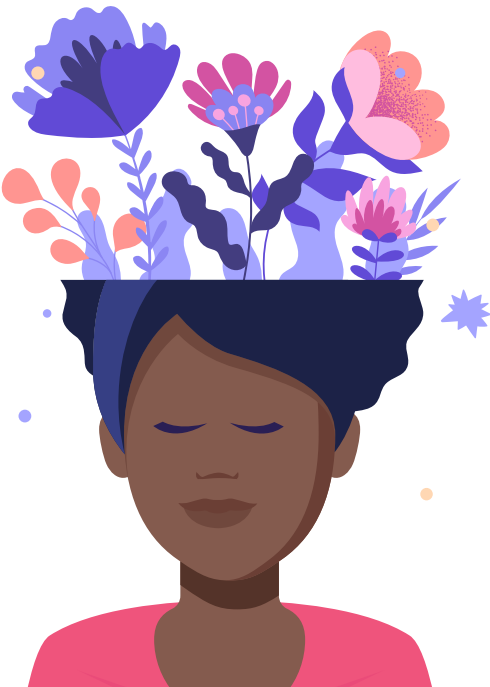

Why did you enrol for the courses?

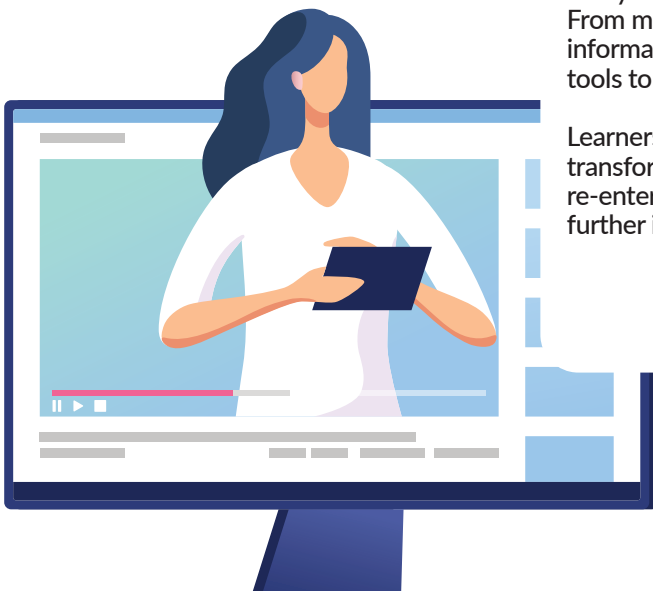
